After breakfast this morning explore Hobart on a **half day tour** that takes in all the highlights including amazing views from the top of **Mt Wellington**, **Australia's oldest brewery**, **Salamanca Place**, **Battery Point**, and the **Botanic Gardens**.

Our tour finishes at the historic **Village of Richmond** where you can spend time exploring the boutiques and enjoy lunch at one of the many Cafes (own expenses).

In the early afternoon we'll travel back to Hobart where the remainder of the day is free to enjoy at your own pace.

Enjoy dinner this evening together at a local restaurant.

Wednesday, 21 April 2021
Port Arthur

This morning after breakfast we will travel via **Sorell Causeway** and **Midway Point** for our full day tour to Tasman Peninsula. Take in magnificent views from the look-out above picturesque **Eaglehawk Neck** and **Pirates Bay** before continuing to the **Port Arthur Convict Settlement**.

Within the 40 hectares of landscaped grounds lies a rich history of Australia's convict past. Included in the entry is a guided walking tour, a short harbour cruise, access to the Visitor Centre and Interpretation Gallery as well as more than 30 buildings, ruins, restored gardens and houses; explore as you wish before departing the historic site to tour beside **Norfolk** and **Frederick Henry Bays** back to Hobart.

Returning to the hotel, there is time to refresh before meeting for dinner.



Thursday, 22 April 2021
Day at Leisure

Today is a free day for you to explore Tasmania's capital city with its history, culture and scenery.

There are many options on offer (own expense) including a visit to the controversial MONA (Museum of Old & New Art); a wilderness cruise to either Tasman Island or Bruny Island; delve into history at the Mawson's Hut Replica Museum and find out what was on their menu; spend time in the shopping precinct or maybe you already have something you know you'd like to do.

In the evening we'll come together for dinner at a local restaurant and share our day.

Friday, 23 April 2021
Derwent Valley & Russell Falls

After breakfast this morning we board the coach and travel through the delightful **Derwent Valley** to **New Norfolk** and spend time at the **Willow Court Antiques Centre**. Within the eclectic mix you're sure to find something of interest for everyone!

We then visit the **Plenty Salmon Ponds** where we will enjoy a **light lunch**. Circa 1861, this is the oldest trout hatchery in the Southern Hemisphere. It was the birthplace of trout in Australia and the origin of Tasmania's legendary trout fishery. Enjoy the original 19th century English style public open space of superb trees, hedges and lawns before visiting **Mt Field National Park** which is one of Tasmania's most loved national parks.

An easy 10 minute stroll will take us to the iconic **Russell Falls**, the track is edged with graceful ferns and giant eucalypts tower overhead.

We return to Hobart following the **Derwent River**.

Freshen up back at the hotel before we meet for our **farewell dinner**.

Saturday, 24 April 2021
Salamanca Markets – Depart Hobart
