Day 1, Arrive Broome

(D)

Welcome to our Pilbara Adventure from stunning Broome to Western Australia's contemporary capital, Perth. Come together for a Welcome Dinner.

Accommodation: Oaks Broome or similar (2 Nights)

Day 2, Broome

(B,L,D)

Discover the rare and beautiful Australian South Sea Cultured Pearl on the award-winning Willie Creek Pearl Farm Tour. The fascinating tour will give us an insight into the process of pearl farming, from shell to showroom. Our visit will also include lunch, a boat cruise and time for some retail therapy. Late afternoon we drive to famous Cable Beach to watch the magical sunset before enjoying dinner.

Day 3, Broome – Port Hedland

(B,L,D)

We have an start to today as we travel through some of the most sparsely populated and remote areas of Australia – skirting the Great Sandy Desert to the east and Eighty Mile Beach to the west. From here we drive to Port Hedland for our overnight stay.

Accommodation: Hospitality Port Hedland or similar (1 Night)

Day 4, Port Hedland – Karijini

(B,L,D)

We join the Great Northern Highway taking us to the Auski Roadhouse where we turn and head into the Hamersley Ranges and the Karijini National Park. For the next two nights we have a unique accommodation experience at the Karijini Eco Retreat, nestled amongst native bushland.

Accommodation: Karijini Eco Retreat, or similar (2 Nights)

Day 5, Karijini & Tom Price

(B,D)

We join Lestock Tours for the Rio Tinto Mine Tour and spend the afternoon exploring the stunning Karijini National Park. From the incredible Oxer Lookout, we get uninterrupted views over the junction of four mighty gorges – Weano, Red, Hancock and Joffre.

Day 6, Karijini – Exmouth

(B,L,D)

There is long travel day ahead as we make our way to Exmouth. We stop for convenience breaks and have time to enjoy our packed lunches. Just off the shore you'll find the clearest turquoise water and the spectacular World Heritage listed Ningaloo Reef.

Accommodation: Potshot Hotel Resort or similar (2 Nights)

Day 7, Exmouth

(B,D)

Explore Exmouth and its surrounds with visits to the United States Naval Communication Station, fantastic views from the Harold Holt Base, Vlaming Lighthouse, Exmouth Beach and the Communication Towers. We also visit Yardie Creek Station, now part of the Cape Range National Park, and enjoy a unique and informative cruise on Yardie Creek before returning to our accommodation.

Day 8, Exmouth – Carnarvon

(B,D)

We adventure to Coral Bay where we join our coral viewing vessel for a cruise around the Ningaloo Marine Park with its remarkable reef. After cruising we leave the North West Cape and travel to Carnarvon for the night.

Accommodation: Hospitality Carnarvon or similar (1 Night)

Day 9, Carnarvon – Monkey Mia

(B,L,D)

We begin our day first stopping at Hamelin Pool to see a colony of Stromatolites (fossil micro-organisms) that date back to the beginning of life on earth. Enjoy lunch at the Telegraph Station before making our way through Denham and Shell Beach to Monkey Mia, our home for tonight.

Accommodation: Monkey Mia Dolphin Resort or similar (1 Night)

Day 10, Monkey Mia – Kalbarri

(B,D)

With any luck after breakfast we'll experience Monkey Mia's well-known wild dolphin encounter. From here we travel to Kalbarri, with stops at Hawks Head for fantastic views of the Murchison River and one of the gorges before a visit to 'The Bluff' lookout.

Accommodation: Kalbarri Edge Resort or similar (1 Night)

Day 11, Kalbarri – Geraldton

(B,L,D)

Mid-morning, we join Kalbarri Wilderness Cruises to experience the wilderness of the Murchison River. Have your camera ready as we see Nature's Window, a natural rock arch which frames the river view perfectly. This afternoon we continue to Geraldton.

Accommodation: Hospitality Geraldton or similar (2 Nights)

Day 12, Geraldton

(B,D)

Our touring takes us around the sights of Geraldton with a local guide including the port area, St Francis Xavier Cathedral and the HMAS Sydney Memorial. We then have an afternoon at leisure before dinner.

Day 13, Geraldton – Perth

(B,L)

We travel south to the town of Cervantes and the remarkable Nambung National Park, where the famous Pinnacles, rise out of the yellow sand dunes. We take a tour through the Pinnacles, as well as enjoy lunch before departing for Perth.

Accommodation: Pan Pacific Perth or similar (2 Nights)

Day 14, Perth

(B,D)

We embark on a sightseeing tour of Perth. Our local guide takes us through the unusual combination of skyscrapers and colonial architecture, among them, Parliament House, St Mary's Cathedral and Government House. We are treated to spectacular views over the city and river from Kings Park before a visit to the Perth Mint. Later we see the imposing Bell Tower and then make our way to the port of Fremantle. See the yacht at the Western Australian Maritime Museum and some of the unique galleries that symbolise WA's maritime past, present and future. Come together for tonight's Farewell Dinner.

Day 15, Depart Perth

(B)

Say goodbye to Perth as we are transferred* to the airport for our flights home.
