Once the group is back together, we take a tour of the town, which will include **Diversion Dam**, **Kellys Knob** and **Ivanhoe Crossing** then visit **Hidden Valley** and **Mirima National Park**.

Bungle Bungle Scenic Flight: On this optional flight over Purnululu National Park see the Bungle Bungle Ranges (own expense). Enjoy the maze of curious orange and black striped beehive shaped domes from above making it the Kimberley's best scenic views.

The additional cost for the optional scenic flight is \$549 per adult (*price is correct as at 31/12//2024 and subject to change by the scenic flight operator*)

- The 2-hour Bungle Bungle Adventurer with Aviair departs at 6am.
- Flights are subject to availability at the time of booking.
- This optional tour does book out quickly so it is advisable to book as early as possible.

Incredible Islands: After your complimentary hotel pick up, you will be brought to the Broome International Airport. Here you will be greeted by your pilot for the day and have the opportunity for a pre-flight tea or coffee in air-conditioned comfort. Your pilot will outline the day's adventure and give a brief safety demonstration before commencing the flight.

The additional cost for the optional tour is \$895 per adult (*price is correct as at 06/02/2024 and subject to change by the scenic flight operator*)

- Departing Broome at 7:45am, track over the Chinatown and Roebuck Bay before heading to the Dampier Peninsula on this Half Day tour.
- View the ancient Kimbolton Ranges and the vastness of King Sound.
- Fly over the '8th Natural Wonder of the World' and witness astonishing rapid tidal movements unique to this region at the Horizontal Waterfalls.
- Marvel at the hundreds of islands that make up the Buccaneer Archipelago including Cockatoo Island and Koolan Island.
- Get an aerial view of Cape Leveque, witnessing the stunning red cliffs that meet the white sand and crystal clear ocean.
- Land at Australia's oldest family owned and operated pearl farm at Cygnet Bay for a delicious breakfast or lunch and time to relax by the pool.
- Take a guided pearl farm tour learning the history of pearling and the methods of cultivating these beautiful and sought after jewels.
- Return to Broome via the coast flying over Pender Bay, Beagle Bay, Carnot Bay, James Price Point, Willie Creek and Cable Beach.
