Day 1 – Monday, 07 September 2026
Arrive Perth

Welcome to Perth, where urban cool meets natural beauty! Bustling with inner city parks, local culture and turquoise beaches. We'll wander Fremantle's portside culture, cruise along the Swan River and discover the hidden gems beyond the city centre.

On arrival at Perth Airport, we meet our driver and are transferred* to our hotel for check in.

There is time to settle into your room and refresh before meeting the group at tonight's **Welcome Dinner**.

Day 2 – Tuesday, 08 September 2026
City Sights

This morning after breakfast we embark on a **sightseeing tour** of Perth, a city with wonderful weather, beautiful beaches and an easy-going character.

Our local guide will take us through the unusual combination of skyscrapers and colonial architecture, among them, **Parliament House, St Mary's Cathedral** and **Government House**. We are then treated to spectacular views over the city and river from **Kings Park**.

We next step inside the historic premises of the **Perth Mint**. Take a guided walk through the world-class exhibition where you can view the world's largest gold coin and witness a mesmerising live gold pour. With an awe-inspiring mix of stories, interactive displays and challenges, you'll be in no doubt as to why The Perth Mint is a premier tourist attraction in Western Australia. Take some time to wander through the grounds, bullion trading room and the shop.

Later today, we visit the imposing **Bell Tower** for a 60 minute tour. Filled with incredible history and boasting a unique and distinctive design, it has become an icon for Perth. The historic ring of bells was given to the people of Western Australia as part of the national Bicentennial celebration and among them includes the twelve bells of St Martin in the Fields. We will have the opportunity to see a demonstration on the art of chiming a bell, learn about the history of the bells and receive a bell chiming certificate.

We return to the hotel where we have time to relax and refresh before this evenings dinner.



Day 3 – Wednesday, 09 September 2026
Fremantle

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we board the coach and travel to the historic port of **Fremantle**. This town is full of well-preserved heritage including the convict built colonial era buildings, the old jetty and the prison.

On the way we have short stop at Cottesloe Beach an iconic beach in Perth, famous for its pristine white sand, crystal-clear waters, and shaded Norfolk Island Pines.

We visit the **Western Australian Maritime Museum** which is perched on the shoreline of the Indian Ocean. The museum is symbolic of Fremantle's past, present and future as a coastal city and port. It houses several unique galleries that explore WA's relationship with the sea. From leisure boats and handcrafted sailing boats to commercial pearl luggers, the museum inspires visitors to discover WA's affinity with the ocean. We will have time to view some of the permanent galleries, and if you'd like to enter one of the special exhibitions this can be done so *at your own expense*.

Late morning we will be transferred to **Old Fremantle Prison** for a "**Behind Bars**" tour, giving a true insight into life as a prisoner. Step inside and discover the prison's history as a maximum security gaol from 1887 to 1991. Find out how a convict built prison transformed into Western Australia's primary place of incarceration for men, women and children. Walk back in time through the Main Cell Block and exercise yards whilst we learn about the daily routine of the prisoners and the realities of life on the inside.

Returning to the hotel, the afternoon is at leisure before we meet for dinner.

Day 4 – Thursday, 10 September 2026
Rottnest Island

After breakfast this morning we are in for a real treat!

Located just off the coast in the warm clear waters of the Indian Ocean, **Rottnest Island** is a spectacular world of white sandy beaches, crystal clear blue waters, abundant marine life, rare marsupials and rich history.

Our day includes transfers from the hotel, return ferry to the island, lunch and 90-minute air-conditioned bus tour of the whole island with expert commentary on island ecology, culture and history – as well as some free time to relax and soak up this tranquil place. So make sure to bring your cameras and for those that wish to take a swim, include your bathing suit and towel in your day pack.

Returning to Barracks Street Jetty late afternoon, our coach will be waiting to transfer us back to our hotel for an evening at leisure.

Stay in and enjoy the hotel facilities or you may like to try another local restaurant.



Day 5 – Friday, 11 September 2026
Day at Leisure
