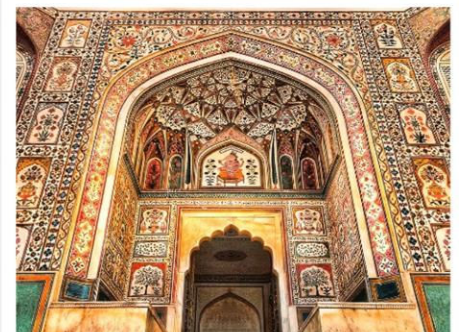

Day 1 – Sunday, 15 March 2026
Arrive Delhi

Day 2 – Monday, 16 March 2026
Delhi

Enjoy breakfast and a leisurely morning.

This afternoon we set out to explore the sights and sounds of **New Delhi** on a sightseeing tour.

Highlights will include the imposing **India Gate memorial**, built in honour of Indian soldiers who lost their lives during the Great War, and a drive past the official residence of the President of India.

We'll also visit the **UNESCO-listed Humayun's Tomb**, a splendid example of Persian-inspired Mughal architecture and the precursor to the Taj Mahal.

Returning to the hotel, freshen up and meet for dinner.

Day 3 – Tuesday, 17 March 2026
Delhi - Agra

Following breakfast this morning, our tour takes us into the heart of **Old Delhi**, where history and spirituality blend seamlessly.

We begin at the serene **Raj Ghat**, the black marble memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi. From here, we continue to the magnificent **Jama Masjid**, one of India's largest mosques, before experiencing the vibrant atmosphere of a traditional **Sikh temple**. A glimpse of the imposing **Red Fort**, the former seat of the Mughal emperors, completes our exploration.

In the afternoon, we board the fast train to the riverside city of **Agra**, home to the world's most celebrated monument of love. Upon arrival we will be transferred to our hotel to check in, freshen up and then come together for dinner.

Day 4 – Wednesday, 18 March 2026

Enjoy breakfast this morning before experiencing your very own Princess Diana moment in front of the breathtaking **Taj Mahal**, a timeless symbol of love and one of the greatest wonders of the world.

Built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, this dazzling white marble masterpiece took over 20,000 skilled artisans to complete. Some see it as a monument of sorrow, while others celebrate it as the ultimate tribute to eternal love.

Later, we visit the imposing **Agra Fort**, a vast walled city that served as the residence of Mughal emperors for centuries. Inside, discover its palaces, mosques, and audience halls, all echoing the grandeur of a bygone era.

We return to the hotel and meet early evening for dinner.

Day 5 – Thursday, 19 March 2026

Agra - Ranthambore

We leave Agra behind this morning after breakfast and journey the 300km (approx. 6 hours) towards **Ranthambore**, pausing en route to visit the remarkable **Abhaneri Stepwell (Chand Baori)**, one of the largest and most intricate stepwells in India.

After some time to enjoy lunch, we continue our drive to **Ranthambore National Park**, famed for its ancient **1,000-year-old fort**, serene lakes, and as one of the best places in the world to spot the majestic **Bengal tiger** in the wild.

We check into our hotel and after some time to settle in, we'll come together for dinner.

This evening we also enjoy an insightful **tiger talk with a local naturalist**, offering fascinating stories and knowledge about the park's wildlife and conservation efforts.

Day 6 – Friday, 20 March 2026

Ranthambore

Ranthambore National Park is a true wildlife haven, and today following breakfast we set out on **two exhilarating game drives** in search of its remarkable inhabitants — from leopards and sloth bears to playful monkeys and vibrant birdlife.

As we listen to the calls of the jungle and breathe in its earthy scents, we may be fortunate enough to encounter the park's most iconic resident — the **elusive Bengal tiger**. Thanks to the dedicated conservation efforts of the **Ranthambore Foundation**, sightings are more possible here than ever before.

Have some time to relax early evening before we meet for dinner.



Day 7 – Saturday, 21 March 2026
Ranthambore - Jaipur

After breakfast and a final game drive, we'll make our way north-west to **Jaipur**, known as the 'pink city' for its rose-red palaces.

Today's drive is roughly 170km (approx. 4 hours) and we'll have a few stops along the way.

Upon arrival we will check into our rooms, have some time to freshen up and then come together for dinner.

Day 8 – Sunday, 22 March 2026
Jaipur

Following breakfast a **full-day exploration of Jaipur** reveals why the Pink City is celebrated as one of India's foremost cultural treasures.

After an early start, we ascend to the magnificent **Amber Fort**, a sandstone and marble stronghold rising majestically above the hills. Inside, its ornate halls and mirrored chambers reflect the grandeur of the Rajput era. At the foothill lake, keep watch for elephants — you may spot them cooling off with a playful bath.

Returning to the heart of Jaipur, we'll wander through the opulent **City Palace**, a harmonious blend of Mughal and Rajasthani design, marvel at the ingenious **Jantar Mantar** observatory with its giant astronomical instruments, and pause to admire the iconic **Hawa Mahal**, or Palace of Winds, with its delicate honeycomb façade.

Have some time at leisure before we meet for dinner.

Day 9 – Wednesday, 23 March 2026
Jaipur - Delhi

Enjoy breakfast before checking and board the coach to begin our journey from Jaipur back to Delhi, 260km (approx. 5-6 hours)

Checking into our hotel, we have time to freshen up before come together for our **Farewell Dinner**.
