Day 3 – Wednesday 23 September 2026

An early start to the day offers a true taste of outback life as we enjoy breakfast before departing on another day of discovery. As the morning light stretches across the vast landscape, we will journey through the heart of Queensland's iconic countryside.

Our first stop is the renowned **Waltzing Matilda Centre in Winton**, a place deeply connected to Australia's most famous bush ballad. Enjoy a self-guided visit through this award-winning museum, where interactive displays and storytelling bring Banjo Paterson's legendary song to life, along with the history and culture of the region. During our visit, a light lunch will be provided, allowing us to relax and soak in the atmosphere.

The adventure continues with a visit to the spectacular **Australian Age of Dinosaurs Museum**, set atop a dramatic mesa with sweeping views across the outback plains. On a guided tour, we explore one of the world's most significant fossil discoveries, gaining insight into Australia's prehistoric past and the dinosaurs that once roamed this ancient land. Learn about the ongoing work of palaeontologists and see real fossil specimens up close.

We return to Longreach with time to freshen up before our **Farewell Dinner** at a much-loved local venue, celebrating our time in the outback with great food and even better company.

Day 4 – Thursday 24 September 2026
Spirit of the Outback

After an early breakfast, we will transfer to the Longreach railway station. We depart at **10:00 am** on board the ***Spirit of the Outback*** for an unforgettable rail experience through Queensland's heartland.

Settle into your overnight single sleeper carriage, a comfortable private space where you can relax and watch the vast outback landscapes drift by. As the train winds its way through Queensland's heartland, enjoy the scenery from your window the rolling plains, grazing cattle, and the wide, open sky that defines this iconic region.
