On arrival into the heart of the Australian Outback, we will be warmly welcomed and transferred to our accommodation in Longreach. Enroute to our accommodation we enjoy a Welcome to Town Tour showcasing key historical landmarks, local points of interest, and insights into the community. Afternoon to refresh then as evening falls, enjoy the captivating Qantas Founders Museum Light & Sound Show, a must-see experience unique to Longreach. Set against the dramatic backdrop of historic aircraft, this immersive presentation uses state-of-the-art lighting, sound, and storytelling to showcase the incredible journey of Qantas and the pioneers of Australian aviation. ### **Day 2, Longreach (B,L,D)**

Our day begins with a visit to the iconic Stockman's Hall of Fame, a world-class tribute to the pioneers who shaped life in the Australian outback. Wander through the museum and galleries, followed by the lively Outback Live Show. After lunch our journey continues at the renowned Qantas Founders Museum. We have a guided Airpark Tour for a close-up look at historic aircraft and hear the fascinating tales behind their legacy. There will then be time to explore the museum, discovering interactive displays and exhibits. Later in the afternoon, return to town and enjoy free time at our leisure.

this evening, prepare for a truly memorable evening on the Drover's Sunset Cruise. This authentic experience includes a delicious two-course camp-oven dinner, followed by freshly baked damper and traditional billy tea served by the campfire. Under a vast, star-filled sky, this peaceful and uniquely Australian experience provides the perfect end to your day in the outback.

### **Day 3, Longreach (B,L,D)**

An early start to the day offers a true taste of outback life as we enjoy breakfast before departing on another day of discovery. As the morning light stretches across the vast landscape, we will journey through the heart of Queensland's iconic countryside. Our first stop is the renowned Waltzing Matilda Centre in Winton, a place deeply connected to Australia's most famous bush ballad. Enjoy a self-guided visit through this award-winning museum, where interactive displays and storytelling bring Banjo Paterson's legendary song to life, along with the history and culture of the region. During our visit, a light lunch will be provided, allowing us to relax and soak in the atmosphere. The adventure continues with a visit to the Australian Age of Dinosaurs Museum, set atop a dramatic mesa with sweeping views across the outback plains. On a guided tour, we explore one of the world's most significant fossil discoveries, gaining insight into Australia's prehistoric past and the dinosaurs that once roamed this ancient land. Learn about the ongoing work of palaeontologists and see real fossil specimens up close. We return to Longreach with time to freshen up before our Farewell Dinner at a much-loved local venue, celebrating our time in the outback with great food and even better company.

### **Day 4, Longreach (B,L,D)**

After an early breakfast, we will transfer to the Longreach railway station. We depart at 10:00 am on board the Spirit of the Outback for an unforgettable rail experience through Queensland's heartland. Settle into your overnight single sleeper carriage, a comfortable private space where you can relax and watch the vast outback landscapes drift by. As the train winds its way through Queensland's heartland, enjoy the scenery from your window the rolling plains, grazing cattle, and the wide, open sky that defines this iconic region. Meals are served in the Tuckerbox Restaurant, where we can enjoy freshly prepared dishes as the outback unfolds outside. Whether you choose to sit back and read, chat with fellow travellers, or simply gaze at the ever-changing vistas, this journey offers a unique perspective on the Australian interior.
