Day 1 – Thursday, 11 February 2027
Arrive Hobart

This morning those passengers travelling from Brisbane will meet with the Tour Host at Brisbane Domestic Airport for the flight to Hobart. Interstate passengers will meet the host and group at Hobart Airport or the hotel.

Welcome to Tasmania's capital city, Hobart, for our culinary journey through the city and its surrounding regions.

After arrival at Hobart Airport, we will travel to our stylish 5 star waterfront accommodation. Settle in and take some time to relax before meeting your fellow travellers for welcome drinks at the hotel's unique luxury lounge bar, **Evolve**, with its botanical, zoological and geological artefacts.

This evenings **Welcome Dinner** is at the famous Tasmanian seafood restaurant **Mures Upper Deck**, a Hobart waterfront icon.

Day 2 – Friday, 12 February 2027
Derwent Valley – Kunanyi – Battery Point

This morning, we depart Hobart and journey into the picturesque **Derwent Valley**, a region rich in history and natural beauty.

Our first stop is the renowned **Salmon Ponds**, set within tranquil, English-style heritage gardens. Take your time to wander along tree-lined paths, cross charming footbridges, and explore the serene ponds teeming with fish. Here, you'll learn about the site's fascinating past as **Australia's oldest trout hatchery**, established in the 1860s, and its role in shaping the country's freshwater fishing industry.

We then continue to the stunning **Derwent Estate Vineyard**, a boutique, biodynamic winery nestled along the banks of the Derwent River. Surrounded by rolling vineyards and sweeping rural views, enjoy a **shared gourmet lunch** showcasing fresh Tasmanian produce. This is a perfect opportunity to relax, savour local flavours, and perhaps sample some of the estate's acclaimed cool-climate wines.

In the afternoon, we ascend to the summit of **kunanyi / Mt Wellington** (weather permitting). Rising dramatically above Hobart, this iconic peak offers **brehtaking panoramic views** across the Derwent Estuary, the city, and beyond to the Tasman Peninsula. Be sure to bring a jacket, as conditions at the summit can be cool and changeable—even in summer.

Descending back into the city, our final stop is the historic waterfront suburb of **Battery Point**. Known for its beautifully preserved sandstone cottages and maritime heritage, this charming neighbourhood invites exploration. Enjoy a **self-guided stroll** through its quiet streets, discovering hidden laneways, quaint gardens, and colonial-era architecture that tells the story of Hobart's early settlement.

We return to the hotel in the late afternoon. This evening is at leisure, perhaps indulge in Hobart's vibrant dining scene, or simply unwind after a day of exploration.



Day 3 – Saturday 13 February 2027

Salamanca Markets, Huon Valley & Convict History

This morning, we'll immerse ourselves in the vibrant atmosphere of Hobart's iconic **Saturday Salamanca Market**, one of Australia's most celebrated open-air markets. Stroll beneath the historic sandstone warehouses as you browse over 300 stalls showcasing gourmet Tasmanian produce, handcrafted goods, artisan products, and unique local designs.

Afterwards, we depart the city and travel south through scenic countryside into the picturesque **Huon Valley**, a region renowned for its fertile farmland, orchards, and cool-climate wines. Our destination is the charming **Home Hill Winery**, beautifully set among rolling vineyards with views to the Huon River. Here, we'll enjoy a **shared gourmet lunch**, highlighting the best of Tasmania's seasonal produce in a peaceful rural setting.

Following lunch, we return to Hobart to visit the **World Heritage-listed Cascades Female Factory**, one of Australia's most important historic sites connected to the female convict experience. Between 1828 and 1856, thousands of women and children passed through this site—living, labouring, and enduring harsh conditions. As you explore the grounds, gain a deeper understanding of the lives of these women and the profound role they played in shaping early Australian society.

This evening, indulge in a memorable dining experience at **Aloft**, one of Hobart's premier waterfront restaurants. Enjoy a carefully curated **degustation menu with matching wines**, showcasing innovative dishes crafted from the finest local ingredients.

Day 4 – Sunday 14 February 2027

Coal River Valley, Richmond & MONA

This morning, we travel into the scenic **Coal River Valley**, one of Tasmania's premier food and wine regions. Our first stop is **Wicked Cheese**, a much-loved artisan producer nestled among rolling countryside. Here, enjoy a **guided cheese tasting**, sampling a range of handcrafted cheeses while learning about traditional cheesemaking techniques and the region's rich agricultural heritage.

We then continue to the historic **Richmond Village**, one of Tasmania's most charming and well-preserved colonial towns. Enjoy time at leisure to explore its quaint streets, where you'll find boutique shops, local galleries, and inviting cafés. Be sure to visit the iconic **Richmond Bridge**, built in 1823 and recognised as Australia's oldest stone bridge still in use, a perfect spot for photos and a glimpse into the past.

Next, we make our way to the extraordinary **MONA (Museum of Old and New Art)**, one of Australia's most talked-about cultural attractions. Set dramatically along the Derwent River, MONA offers a bold and immersive art experience, blending ancient artefacts with provocative contemporary works. During our visit, we enjoy a memorable **lunch at The Source Restaurant**, renowned for its refined, seasonal menu that celebrates the best of Tasmanian produce.

After time to further explore MONA at your own pace, we return to Hobart, arriving at **Constitution Dock**, the historic heart of the city's waterfront. *Note: For those who wish to stay and explore for longer there is the option of catching the MONA ROMA ferry back to Constitution Dock.*

This evening, enjoy a relaxed **in-house dinner at The Old Wharf Restaurant**, where you can unwind and savour a delicious meal in a warm and welcoming atmosphere.



Day 5 – Monday 15 February 2027
Tasman Peninsula

Today we journey to the spectacular **Tasman Peninsula**, renowned for its rugged coastline, towering sea cliffs, and dramatic natural formations. Travelling along scenic coastal roads, we pause at the breathtaking **Pirates Bay Lookout**, where sweeping views stretch across the Tasman Sea and surrounding cliffs—an ideal introduction to this wild and beautiful region.

We continue to **Eaglehawk Neck**, a narrow isthmus steeped in history and surrounded by striking coastal scenery. Nearby, we pass through the delightfully quirky “**Doo Town**”, famous for its collection of holiday shacks with playful names incorporating “doo”, a uniquely Tasmanian curiosity that never fails to amuse.

Our exploration of the peninsula’s natural wonders continues with visits to the remarkable rock formations of **Tasman Arch** and the **Devil’s Kitchen (Devils Cauldron)**. These awe-inspiring geological features, carved by the relentless force of the Southern Ocean, offer dramatic views and excellent photo opportunities.

For lunch, we arrive at the picturesque **Bangor Vineyard Shed**, set overlooking vineyards and the coastline. Here, enjoy a relaxed meal featuring fresh Tasmanian produce, perfectly paired with the serene coastal setting.

In the afternoon, we visit **Hellfire Bluff Distillery**, a boutique producer known for its small-batch, handcrafted spirits. Enjoy a tasting experience while learning about the distillation process and the passion behind this uniquely Tasmanian operation.

We return to Hobart in the mid-afternoon, giving you time to relax and freshen up before, we gather for a memorable **farewell dinner at Peppina Restaurant**, where Italian-inspired dishes are designed to be shared. Showcasing the best of Tasmanian ingredients with a warm, convivial atmosphere, it’s the perfect way to celebrate the journey and reflect on the experiences of the past few days.

Day 5 – Monday 15 February 2027
Depart Hobart

This morning, we bid farewell to Hobart after a memorable journey through Tasmania’s stunning landscapes, rich history, and exceptional food and wine.

We make a final stop at **Barilla Bay Oyster Farm**, beautifully situated overlooking the water.
