Brisbane to Toowoomba

Known for its cool climate, vineyards, orchards, and striking granite landscapes, this part of the state offers some of the most picturesque scenery in regional Queensland.

Our first stop is the iconic **Big Apple** in Stanthorpe, the perfect place for a fun group photo and a chance to stretch the legs. Stanthorpe is renowned for its apple orchards and fresh produce, and the Big Apple has become one of the region's best loved landmarks. A must see is the famous **Tenterfield Saddler**, one of the town's most iconic landmarks. Steeped in history and made famous by Peter Allen's beloved song, the saddlery offers a fascinating glimpse into Australia's pioneering past and remains a treasured piece of local heritage.

Leaving Tenterfield behind, we continue a scenic winding drive through rolling countryside, picturesque farmland, and lush hinterland landscapes as we make our way towards **Casino**, known as the "Beef Capital" of Australia. Here we stop for a relaxed pub counter lunch at the historic Cecil Hotel, giving you the chance to enjoy a hearty meal, stretch the legs, and share stories from the journey so far.

This afternoon we continue east towards the coast, arriving in beautiful Ballina with time to settle into our accommodation, freshen up, and perhaps enjoy a short stroll along the river front before dinner.
