Day 1, Arrive Hobart (D)

Welcome to Tasmania! After arrival at Hobart Airport, we will travel to our 5-star waterfront accommodation. Settle in and relax before meeting your fellow travellers for drinks. This evenings Welcome Dinner is at the Tasmanian seafood restaurant Mures Upper Deck, a Hobart waterfront icon. Accommodation: MACq01 Hotel – 5 star – or similar (5 nights)

Day 2, Hobart (B,L)

Today, we journey into the Derwent Valley, a region rich in history and natural beauty. Our first stop is the Salmon Ponds. Here, you'll learn about the site's fascinating past as Australia's oldest trout hatchery. We then continue to the Derwent Estate Vineyard, nestled along the banks of the Derwent River. Enjoy a shared gourmet lunch showcasing fresh Tasmanian produce. In the afternoon, we ascend to the summit of kunanyi / Mt Wellington (weather permitting). This iconic peak offers breathtaking panoramic views across the Derwent Estuary, the city, and beyond to the Tasman Peninsula. Descending back into the city, our final stop is the historic waterfront suburb of Battery Point. Known for its beautifully preserved sandstone cottages and maritime heritage, this charming neighbourhood invites exploration. Enjoy a self-guided stroll through its quiet streets, discovering hidden laneways, quaint gardens, and colonial-era architecture that tells the story of Hobart's early settlement. We return to the hotel in the late afternoon, with dinner this evening is at leisure.

Day 3, Hobart (B,L,D)

This morning, we visit Hobart's iconic Saturday Salamanca Market, one of Australia's most celebrated open-air markets. Browse over 300 stalls showcasing gourmet Tasmanian produce, handcrafted goods, artisan products, and unique local designs. Afterwards, we depart for Huon Valley, a region renowned for its fertile farmland, orchards, and cool-climate wines. Our destination is the charming Home Hill Winery, beautifully set among rolling vineyards with views to the Huon River. Here, we'll enjoy a shared gourmet lunch. Following lunch, we return to Hobart to visit the World Heritage-listed Cascades Female Factory, one of Australia's most important historic sites connected to the female convict experience. This evening, indulge in a memorable dining experience at Aloft, one of Hobart's premier waterfront restaurants. Enjoy a carefully curated degustation menu with matching wines, showcasing innovative dishes crafted from the finest local ingredients.

Day 4, Hobart (B,L,D)

This morning, we travel into the scenic Coal River Valley, a premier food and wine regions. Our first stop is Wicked Cheese, a much-loved artisan producer. Here, enjoy a guided cheese tasting, sampling a range of handcrafted cheeses while learning about traditional cheesemaking techniques. We then continue to the historic Richmond Village, one of Tasmania's most charming and well-preserved colonial towns. Enjoy time at leisure to explore its quaint streets, where you'll find boutique shops, local galleries, and inviting cafés. Next, we make our way to the extraordinary MONA (Museum of Old and New Art). Set along the Derwent River, MONA offers a bold and immersive art experience, blending ancient artefacts with provocative contemporary works. During our visit, we enjoy a memorable lunch at The Source Restaurant, renowned for its refined, seasonal menu that celebrates the best of Tasmanian produce. After time to further explore MONA at your own pace, we return to Hobart, arriving at Constitution Dock. This evening, enjoy a relaxed in-house dinner at The Old Wharf Restaurant.

Day 5, Hobart (B,D)

Today we journey to the spectacular Tasman Peninsula, renowned for its rugged coastline, towering sea cliffs, and dramatic natural formations. Travelling along scenic coastal roads, we pause at Pirates Bay Lookout, where sweeping views stretch across the Tasman Sea and surrounding cliffs. We continue to Eaglehawk Neck, surrounded by striking coastal scenery. Nearby, we pass through the delightfully quirky "Doo Town", famous for its collection of holiday shacks with playful names incorporating "doo". Our exploration of the peninsula's natural wonders continues with visits to the remarkable rock formations of Tasman Arch and the Devil's Kitchen (Devils Cauldron). For lunch, we arrive at the picturesque Bangor Vineyard Shed, set overlooking vineyards and the coastline. Here, enjoy a relaxed meal featuring fresh Tasmanian produce, perfectly paired with the serene coastal setting. In the afternoon, we visit Hellfire Bluff Distillery, a boutique producer known for its small-batch, handcrafted spirits. Enjoy a tasting experience while learning about the distillation process. We return to Hobart in the mid-afternoon, giving you time to freshen up before we gather for a memorable farewell dinner at Peppina Restaurant, serving Italian-inspired shared dishes.

Day 6, Depart Hobart (B)

This morning, we bid farewell to Hobart. We make a final stop at Barilla Bay Oyster Farm, beautifully situated overlooking the water. Here, we enjoy a guided oyster experience, where you'll learn about the cultivation and harvesting of Tasmania's renowned oysters. Afterwards, we continue to Hobart Airport, where our tour concludes and we return with wonderful memories of Tasmania's natural beauty, warm hospitality, and unique experiences.
