Day 1, Arrive Melbourne (D)

Welcome to Melbourne! Upon arrival, we will collect our luggage and take a short walk across to our conveniently located hotel for our overnight stay. After check-in, there will be time to settle in and freshen up before we come together for a Welcome Dinner at the hotel's onsite restaurant. Accommodation: Parkroyal Melbourne Airport - 4.5 star or similar (1 night)

Day 2, King Island (B-HT-D)

After breakfast, we set out to discover the highlights of Melbourne on a guided sightseeing drive through the city. Our morning continues with a visit to the renowned National Gallery of Victoria, Australia's oldest and most visited art museum. Home to an extraordinary collection of more than 70,000 works spanning thousands of years, the gallery showcases an inspiring mix of international and Australian art, ideas, and cultures. Enjoy time to explore the gallery at your own pace before we gather for a delightful High Tea in the elegant Tea Room. We return to the Parkroyal Melbourne Airport to collect our luggage before making our way to the terminal to board our lunchtime flight to King Island, where the next chapter of your adventure begins. This afternoon, we arrive on beautiful King Island where we are welcomed and transferred to Currie, the island's picturesque main township. En route, enjoy an introductory tour showcasing the island's fascinating history, dramatic coastal scenery, and local landmarks. Following our tour, we check in to our accommodation, and you will have time to settle in before coming together for dinner at the acclaimed Wild Harvest Restaurant. This evening we get to know our fellow travellers while enjoying the fresh local flavours for which King Island is renowned. Accommodation: Island Breeze - 3.5 star or similar (4 nights)

Day 3, King Island (B-MT-L-D)

After breakfast, we set off to explore King Island's spectacular northern coastline. Our first stop is Reekara Top Shop, where we enjoy morning tea and can browse and purchase locally made arts and crafts. We continue to Quarantine Bay and the sweeping sands of Martha Lavinia Beach, where rugged coastal scenery and open ocean views capture the wild beauty of this remote part of the island. Lunch is enjoyed beside the unique perched lake of Penny's Lagoon before our afternoon sightseeing continues to Martha Lavinia, Disappointment Bay, the iconic Cape Wickham Lighthouse, and the spectacular Cape Wickham Golf Course, dramatically positioned above the Southern Ocean. Later, we return to Island Breeze for a rest before dinner at the King Island Golf & Bowling Club. This evening, enjoy a special wildlife experience at Grassy Harbour, where we watch Little Penguins return ashore after dark a memorable end to a wonderful day on King Island.

Day 4, King Island (B-MT-L-D)

Our morning starts with a visit to the historic Jetty, followed by a relaxed morning tea on the Esplanade, where we can take in the coastal views and fresh sea air. We then travel to Sea Elephant, a beautiful estuary renowned for its abundant birdlife and stunning natural scenery. Lunch is enjoyed at the King Island Brewhouse, where we savour locally sourced produce and beverages that showcase the island's rich food culture. This afternoon, we venture south to Seal Rocks and the remarkable Calcified Forest, one of King Island's most fascinating natural attractions. A guided walk provides insight into the area's unique geological formations and history. We continue to Raff Farm for a glimpse into rural island life and local farming traditions before enjoying a short tour of the township of Grassy. This evening, we gather for dinner at the King Island Hotel, sharing stories from another memorable day of discovery before returning to our accommodation.

Day 5, King Island (B-L-D)

Today is a celebration of King Island's renowned food culture as we embark on a delightful culinary experience showcasing the island's exceptional local produce. We are welcomed to the private property of a local chef for an exclusive and intimate experience, featuring a cooking demonstration, a delicious lunch, and a guided tour of the grounds. This unique opportunity offers an insight into the passion, creativity, and fresh ingredients that have made King Island famous among food lovers. Enjoy time to relax, savour the flavours, and connect with the people and stories behind the island's thriving food scene. This evening, we come together one final time for a memorable Farewell Dinner at Oleada's.

Day 6, Depart King Island (B)
