Day 1, Arrive Amsterdam

On arrival into Amsterdam International Airport be welcomed by a representative and our group transfer to our accommodation. After check in and have some time to relax before this evenings Welcome Dinner. Accommodation – INK Hotel Amsterdam by MGallery - 4 star or similar (1 Night)

Day 2, Amsterdam

(B-L-D)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we take a walking city tour. Our local guide will take us to the main sights - Dam Square, Van Gogh Museum, Royal Palace of Amsterdam and Rijksmuseum. At the conclusion of the tour we have lunch in a local restaurant before being transferred to the river cruise ship. Upon embarkation of the ship, we have time to settle into our cabins before this evening's Welcome Dinner, including a performance by a traditional shanty choir. Day 3, Amsterdam & Utrecht

(B-L-D)

Our journey begins with a delightful canal cruise along Amsterdam's iconic waterways, followed by an excursion to the Waterland region. On the city tour through the Dutch metropolis, you will see the Royal Palace, numerous canals and the Museum Quarter. As there is no better way to see the city than cruising on the water, the tour will end by a canal cruise boat trip. Returning to the vessel in Utrecht just in time for lunch, we set sail to explore the scenic waters of the Netherlands. Indulge in a delicious dinner this evening, as we continue our journey through the Dutch countryside.

Day 4, Cologne

(B-L-D)

We rise to the vibrant cityscape of Cologne, Germany's fourth-largest city, where the iconic twin spires of the Cologne Cathedral stand tall. Embark on a morning walking tour through the city, immersing yourself in its rich history and cultural heritage. During the walking tour, explore the area around the cathedral all the way to the old town. As the excursion concludes, we are invited to enjoy a glass of typical Kölsch (beer), before returning to the ship for lunch. Please note: The visit of the Cologne Cathedral depends on the opening hours, Holy Masses, etc. This evening, as we sail towards Ruedesheim, take in the enchanting scenery from the comfort of our ship.

Day 5, Ruedesheim

(B-L-D)

The day commences as we navigate through the legendary Lorelei passage in the Upper Middle Rhine Valley. As noon approaches, we arrive in Ruedesheim, a picturesque town celebrated for its winemaking heritage. Embarking on a guided walking tour, we delve into the rich tapestry of the region's history, while also indulging in the captivating collection of musical instruments showcased at the Music Cabinet Museum. We continue our guided tour with a walk through town. Explore the heart of the old town of Ruedesheim - the Drosselgasse - where wine houses and garden taverns invite you to linger. Immerse yourself in the history of the city and visit the Eagle Tower, a part of the city wall, and the fortifications from the 15th century.

Day 6, Miltenberg & Wertheim

(B-L-D)

Following a serene morning aboard, we embark on an afternoon adventure to Miltenberg and Wertheim. Our journey first takes us to Wertheim, touring through medieval alleys lined with half-timbered houses and visit the unique glass museum. During a tour of the museum we will learn interesting facts about glass and you can observe glassblowers at work. We then make our way to Miltenberg, boasting Miltenberg Castle and the renowned Hotel "Zum Riesen," one of Germany's oldest inns. We enjoy a guided tour through the charming town before returning to the ship for dinner.

Day 7, Würzburg

(B-L-D)

Our journey brings us to Würzburg. In the morning, we immerse ourselves in the town's captivating beauty, including a visit to the Residenz. Experience many beautiful sights in the old town of Würzburg, such as the marketplace, the Maria Chapel and the old main bridge and the Würzburg Residence. Afterwards, will join a guided tour of the ancient wine cellar of a local vineyard, where we sample a glass of wine. This afternoon, unwind aboard the ship with dinner.

Day 8, Bamberg

(B-L-D)

We leisurely cruise along the scenic Main River, offering you the perfect opportunity to unwind. Following lunch, we embark on a guided walking tour of Bamberg. During the walk, we'll see magnificent sights such as the imperial cathedral, the old imperial residence, the new residence palace and rose garden, the old town hall and the former fishing village that is now Bamberg's "Little Venice" area. Upon our return to the ship, we journey towards Nuremberg. Tonight, you're invited to join a presentation discussing the canal, which facilitates seamless navigation between the North Sea and the Black Sea.

Day 9, Nuremberg

(B-L-D)

Today, we set our sights on the city of Nuremberg. A walking tour leads us to the major sites and highlights of the city, from its medieval beginnings to the present. Our tour includes a visit to a Gingerbread Specialties shop for a taste of this famous treat Lebkuchen. Returning to the ship, we set course for Regensburg, cruising through the passage of the Continental Divide.

Day 10, Regensburg

(B-L-D)

Today we arrive in Regensburg. Among its architectural gems are churches, monasteries, the town hall, and Europe's venerable Danube Bridge. Embarking on a guided walking tour through the city we discover one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Germany. At the end of the tour, we reach one of Regensburg's typical small breweries. Enjoy a guided tour of the brewery and a tasting of the local beer, before we return to the ship. We spend the afternoon cruising the Danube's scenic waterways and then Bavarian delights await us with a special themed dinner menu and festive celebrations.

Day 11, Passau

(B-L-D)

On our guided culinary tour through Passau, the tour guide leads us on a two-hour exploration of regional delights. From traditional Bavarian cuisine to local delicacies, from sweet indulgences to hearty treats – all accompanied by the unmistakable scent of Bavarian tavern culture. As evening falls, indulge in dinner aboard the ship as we continue our journey.

Day 12, Emmersdorf & Durnstein

(B-L-D)

We awaken today in Emmersdorf, in the heart of the Wachau Valley. A guided tour of the Melk Abbey takes us through the abbot's chambers, along the emperor's walk, the marble hall, the balconies and the library. After lunch onboard, the ship will dock in the village of Durnstein. As we walk past the town hall and castle ruins, our guide will make stops for us to savour treats made with the local specialty – Apricots. Indulge your taste buds with a sip of an Apricot juice, brandy or liquor, before continuing your walk to the charming 700-year old Schloss Durnstein. We make a stop to explore the famous Abbey and enjoy a glass of wine. Back on board, the ship arrives into and remains overnight in Vienna.

Day 13, Vienna

(B-L-D)

This morning Vienna beckons. We embark on a drive along the famed Ringstrasse, and marvel at the magnificent Vienna State Opera House, the Museum Quarter and more. Following the drive, we are taken on a guided walking tour through the city centre, including the Hofburg Imperial Palace, the Kohl market, and the iconic St. Stephen's Cathedral. In the afternoon we travel by coach to Schönbrunn Palace. Visit many of the ceremonial rooms and then have the opportunity to walk around the beautifully designed gardens of the palace. After a full day of exploration, enjoy a multicourse dinner on board.

Day 14, Bratislava

(B-L-D)

Upon our arrival into Bratislava, we'll embark on a driving tour that passes St. Martin's Cathedral and the Grassalkovich Palace and continues to the castle hill. Afterwards a guided walking tour leads us through the old town. Take a leisurely stroll from Michael's Gate through the historic city centre sights such as the Primatial Palace, St. Martin's Cathedral and Academia Istropolitana. See the main square with the old City Hall, the Opera House and Maximilian Fountain. We will end our walk at the historical Opera House in front of glorious Ganymede's Fountain. You are then free to explore further or walk the short distance back to the ship. As evening descends, we gather for the much anticipated Captain's Gala Dinner.

Day 15, Budapest

(B-L-D)

This morning, we embark on a city tour to immerse ourselves in Budapest's history and culture. The Danube flows through the city, dividing it into two parts: Buda and Pest. The tour first takes us through Pest, past the Great Market Hall. We will see splendid Baroque buildings such as the Hungarian State Opera in Neo-Renaissance style and the incomparable parliament building. We continue across one of the seven bridges into Buda and go up to Castle Hill, where we will visit St. Matthew's Church and the famous Fisherman's Bastion (provided that it is open to the public). Enjoy the unforgettable view over the city before returning to the vessel. As night falls, indulge in the atmosphere of Budapest with a Hungarian folklore show and an evening cruise through the "Paris of the East" aboard our Amadeus Vessel. A perfect end to our cruise.

Day 16, Depart Budapest

(B)

This morning we are bid farewell after breakfast and those returning to Australia will board our coach for a city sightseeing tour before being transferred to the Budapest International Airport to begin our journey back with many new memories and friends.
