Day 1 – Friday, 01 October 2027
Arrive Delhi

Namaste - The most common, universal greeting to use in India

Upon arrival at Delhi International Airport late today, we are welcome by a local Tour Guide and Driver who will accompany to our touring coach before transferring us to the hotel.

We'll check into our rooms and turn in for the night. Adventure await us in the morning!

Day 2 – Saturday, 02 October 2027
Delhi

Following breakfast this morning we set out to explore the sights and sounds of **Delhi** on a sightseeing tour.

We first go to the magnificent **Jama Masjid**, one of India's largest mosques, the largest Mosque in India. Visit **Chandni Chowk** – oldest, biggest bazaar of Old Delhi. Today at **Chandni Chowk**, explore the narrow alleys & colorful markets & local shoppers.

Later, we will walk up to Fatehpuri Masjid and enjoy a **rickshaw ride** till Red Fort. Here our driver will meet you, drive past **Red Fort** (a 17th century historical fort in Delhi) and reach **Rajghat**, a memorial where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated. An eternal flame burns on one side of this memorial.

Visit the **Humayun's Tomb**, the first garden-style tomb of India. The main highlight of this tomb, inspired by Persian architecture, is the four garden squares with water passage channels surrounding the tomb. We'll drive past **Rashtrapati Bhawan**, residence of the President of India and **India Gate**, an archway built in honour of the soldiers who died in World War I. We'll also visit **Qutub Minar** built by Qutab-ud-din Aibak in 1193 to mark the beginning of Muslim rule in India.

Returning to the hotel, freshen up and meet for a **Welcome Dinner**.

Day 3 – Sunday, 03 October 2027
Delhi - Agra

This morning after breakfast we check out and take a fast train to the riverside city of **Agra**, home to the world's most celebrated monument of love.

Upon arrival we will be transferred to our hotel to check in, and after the remainder of the day at leisure before coming together for dinner.

Day 4 – Monday, 04 October 2027
Agra

Enjoy breakfast this morning before experiencing your very own Princess Diana moment in front of the breathtaking **Taj Mahal**, a timeless symbol of love and one of the greatest wonders of the world.

Built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, this dazzling white marble masterpiece took over 20,000 skilled artisans to complete. Some see it as a monument of sorrow, while others celebrate it as the ultimate tribute to eternal love.

Later, we visit the imposing **Agra Fort**, a vast walled city that served as the residence of Mughal emperors for centuries. Inside, discover its palaces, mosques, and audience halls, all echoing the grandeur of a bygone era.

We return to the hotel and meet early evening for dinner.

Day 5 – Tuesday, 05 October 2027
Agra - Ranthambore

We leave Agra behind this morning after an early breakfast and journey the 300km (approx. 6 hours) towards **Ranthambore**, pausing en route to visit the remarkable **Abhaneri Stepwell (Chand Baori)**, one of the largest and most intricate stepwells in India.

After some time to enjoy lunch, we continue our drive to **Ranthambore National Park**, famed for its ancient **1,000-year-old fort**, serene lakes, and as one of the best places in the world to spot the majestic **Bengal tiger** in the wild.

We check into our hotel and after some time to settle in, we'll come together for dinner.

Day 6 – Wednesday, 06 October 2027
Ranthambore

Ranthambore National Park is a true wildlife haven and today following breakfast we set out on **two exhilarating game drives** in search of its remarkable inhabitants — from leopards and sloth bears to playful monkeys and vibrant birdlife.

As we listen to the calls of the jungle and breathe in its earthy scents, we may be fortunate enough to encounter the park's most iconic resident — the **elusive Bengal tiger**. Thanks to the dedicated conservation efforts of the **Ranthambore Foundation**, sightings are more possible here than ever before.

Have some time to relax early evening before we meet for dinner.



Day 7 – Thursday, 07 October 2027
Ranthambore - Jaipur

After breakfast we'll be making our way north-west to **Jaipur**, known as the 'pink city' for its rose-red palaces.

Today's drive is roughly 170km (approx. 4 hours) and we'll have a few stops along the way.

Upon arrival we will check into our rooms, have some time to freshen up and then come together for dinner.

Day 8 – Friday, 08 October 2027
Jaipur

Following breakfast a **full-day exploration of Jaipur** reveals why the Pink City is celebrated as one of India's foremost cultural treasures.

After an early start, we ascend to the magnificent **Amber Fort**, a sandstone and marble stronghold rising majestically above the hills. Inside, its ornate halls and mirrored chambers reflect the grandeur of the Rajput era. At the foothill lake, keep watch for elephants — you may spot them cooling off with a playful bath.

Returning to the heart of Jaipur, we'll wander through the opulent **City Palace**, a harmonious blend of Mughal and Rajasthani design, marvel at the ingenious **Jantar Mantar** observatory with its giant astronomical instruments, and pause to admire the iconic **Hawa Mahal**, or Palace of Winds, with its delicate honeycomb façade.

Have some time at leisure before we meet for dinner.

Day 9 – Saturday, 09 October 2027
Jaipur

Today we will be a full day at leisure. Have breakfast at your own pace before spending the day either enjoying the hotels facilities or perhaps do some shopping or further self-exploration.
