Day 1 – Wednesday, 14 April 2027
Arrive Broken Hill

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This morning those passengers travelling from Brisbane will meet with the Tour Host at Brisbane Domestic Airport for the flight to Broken Hill. Interstate passengers will meet the host and group at Broken Hill Airport or the hotel.

Your Outback Air Adventure begins in the iconic mining city of **Broken Hill**, the gateway to one of Australia's most remarkable outback journeys. Together with our local guide, we embark on a fascinating tour of Australia's first heritage-listed city, discovering its rich mining history, impressive heritage buildings, vibrant arts scene and unique outback character.

We pause for lunch (*own expense*) at the renowned **Broken Earth Restaurant**, where we can enjoy regional flavours while taking in sweeping views across the rugged outback landscape. We then continue exploring Broken Hill before checking into our accommodation, where we will have time to relax and freshen up.

Later this afternoon, we travel to the spectacular **Living Desert and Sculptures**. Perched atop Sundown Hill, this collection of twelve internationally acclaimed sandstone sculptures provides the perfect setting to experience a magnificent outback sunset. As the colours of the landscape transform before our eyes, we enjoy drinks and canapés while taking in this unforgettable setting.

This evening, we gather for our **Welcome Dinner** at the historic **Tipsy Camel**. Housed within one of Broken Hill's original breweries, this iconic venue offers the perfect atmosphere to relax, enjoy a delicious meal and get to know your fellow travellers as we celebrate the beginning of your Outback Air Adventure.

Day 2 – Thursday, 15 April 2027
Innamincka, Diamantina & Birdsville

IMPORTANT NOTE: For the next 3 days as we are travelling by Air all passengers are restricted to a maximum of 7kg of luggage per person, total. After breakfast, we begin the next stage of your Outback Air Adventure as we board our private **Cessna Grand Caravan 208 charter aircraft**.

Taking to the skies, we leave Broken Hill behind and enjoy spectacular aerial views of the rugged outback, flying over the historic township of **Tibooburra** and the winding waterways of **Cooper Creek**.

Our journey continues to the remote outback settlement of **Innamincka**, where we pause to stretch our legs, explore this iconic destination and enjoy lunch.



Back in the air, we soar above the internationally significant **Coongie Lakes** and the vast **Diamantina region**, offering a unique perspective of one of Australia's most extraordinary landscapes. This unforgettable flight showcases the immense beauty and remoteness of the Australian Outback before we arrive in the legendary town of **Birdsville**.

Nestled on the edge of the Simpson Desert and steeped in outback history, Birdsville welcomes us with its warm hospitality, rich pioneering heritage and unforgettable red desert landscapes.

Day 3 – Friday, 16 April 2027

Lake Eyre, Simpson Desert, Painted Hills & Willam Creek

After breakfast in Birdsville, we take off on an unforgettable flight westward. Our route takes us over the legendary **Big Red sand dune**, the expansive **Goyder Lagoon**, **Clifton Hills Station**, and the **Simpson Desert**.

We continue along the winding path of the **Warburton River** and soar across the surreal salt pans of **Lake Eyre North**, including stunning landmarks like **Halligan Bay**, **Belt Bay**, and the **Silcrete and Dalhenty Islands**.

We arrive in the tiny township of **William Creek**, one of the most remote settlements in Australia.

In the afternoon, we enjoy a scenic flight to the Anna Creek **Painted Hills**. Here, we stretch our legs with a guided walk among the rugged formations, taking in the vibrant ochre tones and unique geology.

Late afternoon we return to William Creek for dinner.

Day 4 – Saturday, 17 April 2027

Arkaroola, Lake Frome, Broken Hill

This morning, we begin our return journey to Broken Hill, flying over a series of captivating outback landmarks. Highlights include the enigmatic **Marree Man geoglyph**, the ancient mountain ranges of **Arkaroola**, and the shimmering surface of **Lake Frome**.

Arriving back to Broken Hill, we visit the fascinating **Royal Flying Doctor Service Visitor Centre** to learn about the extraordinary work of this essential service and gain an insight into life in remote Australia.

Following lunch at a local venue, we continue our sightseeing with a visit to the colourful **Big Picture**, one of the largest indoor acrylic paintings in the Southern Hemisphere.

We then explore the famous **Pro Hart Gallery**, showcasing the works and life story of one of Australia's most beloved artists.

The remainder of the evening is at leisure to enjoy dinner and relax.

Darling River, Kinchega National Park, Astronomy Show

Today we travel through spectacular outback scenery to the historic township of **Menindee**, situated on the banks of the **Darling River**.

Along the way we enjoy morning tea and learn about the region's rich pastoral and exploration history. Our journey continues into **Kinchega National Park**, renowned for its ancient river red gums, abundant birdlife and significant cultural heritage.

After exploring the park, we enjoy lunch at the historic **Maidens Hotel**, a true outback institution. As evening falls, we experience the magic of the Australian night sky with a memorable **Outback Astronomy Sky Show**.

Away from city lights, marvel at the brilliant stars and constellations while learning fascinating stories of the cosmos and Indigenous connections to the night sky.

Day 6 – Monday, 19 April 2027

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Depart Broken Hill

This morning, enjoy breakfast before checking out of our accommodation.

We then transfer to the Broken Hill airport for our flights home, departing with wonderful memories of the Channel Country history, unique landscapes and warm country hospitality.
