**Day 1 – Monday, 19 July 2027**  
**Arrive Uluru**

*This morning those passengers travelling from Brisbane will meet with the Tour Host at Brisbane Domestic Airport for the flight to Ayres Rock. Interstate passengers will meet the host and group at Ayres Rock Airport or the hotel.*

On arrival at Ayers Rock Airport, we will be met and transferred to the Desert Gardens Hotel, our home for the next four nights. After time to settle in, rejoin your fellow travellers as our Red Centre adventure begins.

This evening, enjoy one of Australia's most iconic dining experiences, the **Sounds of Silence Dinner**.

We begin with canapés and a glass of sparkling wine while taking in spectacular views across Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park as the sun sets over the desert landscape. It's the perfect opportunity to get to know your travelling companions in a relaxed and unforgettable setting.

As darkness falls, take your seat beneath a canopy of stars for a memorable three course dinner showcasing native Australian flavours. During the evening, listen to the haunting sounds of the didgeridoo before an expert star talker reveals the wonders of the southern night sky. Learn to identify the Southern Cross, the Milky Way, planets and distant galaxies, all visible thanks to the exceptional clarity of the Outback atmosphere.

After an unforgettable evening of food, conversation and stargazing, return to your hotel where the excitement builds for the adventures ahead.

**Day 2 – Tuesday, 20 July 2027**

**Desert Awakenings, Uluru & Field of Light**

Rise early this morning for the unforgettable **Desert Awakenings** experience when we travel into the quiet pre-dawn desert and experience the tranquillity of the landscape beneath a canopy of stars.

As the first rays of sunlight appear, we watch the colours of the desert transform with Uluru and Kata Tjuta providing a spectacular backdrop. Accompanied by an expert guide, we discover the natural beauty and rich cultural significance of this remarkable region.

As the distant domes of Kata Tjuta emerge in the morning light, we will enjoy a traditional Australian breakfast in the open-air featuring bacon and egg rolls, homemade damper with syrup, tea and coffee.

After breakfast, our guide will explain the natural history of the area and reveal the many animal tracks left in the sand overnight, offering a fascinating insight into the desert's nocturnal wildlife. We then continue to the base of Uluru for a guided walk where we will see the **tjukuritja**, the physical evidence of the Mala Tjukurpa creation story, and gain a deeper appreciation of the cultural importance of this sacred landscape.



Returning to the hotel in time for lunch we can then enjoy a free afternoon to relax or make use of the resort facilities.

This evening, experience Bruce Munro's internationally acclaimed **Field of Light**, celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2026.

Our evening begins with a short transfer to a private dune overlooking Uluru at sunset. Enjoy four outback-inspired canapés accompanied by Australian wines, beer and non-alcoholic beverages while our guide shares stories about the artwork and the surrounding landscape.

As darkness falls, we can wander at our own pace through the stunning installation of more than 50,000 illuminated glass spheres stretching across the desert. Watch the colours gently shift through shades of ochre, violet, blue and soft white, creating an unforgettable experience beneath the brilliant outback night sky.

We return to our accommodation later this evening after a truly memorable day in the heart of Australia's Red Centre.

**Day 3 – Wednesday 21 July 2027**  
**Uluru, Uluru Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre**

Today, we discover the spiritual heart of Australia's Red Centre when we journey through the spectacular landscapes of Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park.

This immersive experience combines breathtaking scenery with the rich cultural heritage of the Anangu people, offering a deeper understanding of one of Australia's most significant World Heritage listed destinations.

We will begin at the magnificent **Kata Tjuta**, where 36 ancient sandstone domes rise dramatically from the desert floor. On arrival, enjoy the **Walpa Gorge Walk**, following a natural creek bed between towering red cliffs. Along the way, our guide will explain the geological formation of the domes, their cultural significance to the Anangu people and the unique plants and wildlife that thrive in this remarkable environment.

Next, we make our way to the **Uluru Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre**, where we gain a fascinating insight into Anangu traditions, including **Tjukurpa**, the foundation of Anangu law, culture and spirituality. We can browse informative displays and locally produced artworks while learning about the ongoing efforts to protect and preserve this sacred landscape.

Following lunch, we continue to the base of **Uluru** for a guided walk along the renowned **Kuniya Walk**. Discover ancient rock art, visit the peaceful Mutitjulu Waterhole and hear the stories that have been passed down through countless generations. As we walk alongside the immense sandstone monolith, our guide will reveal the cultural significance of the sites and explain the enduring connection between the Anangu people and their Country.

After this unforgettable cultural experience, we will return to the hotel where the remainder of the afternoon and evening is free to relax, enjoy the resort facilities or spend time with fellow travellers reflecting on the day's adventures.



**Day 4 – Thursday, 22 July 2027**  
**Resort Leisure, Uluru Sunset and BBQ Dinner**

Enjoy a relaxed **day at leisure**, with time to make the most of the resort facilities. After sunset, we continue to an exclusive venue for a memorable **BBQ Farewell Dinner** with Uluru as our backdrop. Dine on favourites from the grill, freshly prepared salads and dessert while celebrating the friendships and moments from our Red Centre adventure.

Later, settle back for a guided tour of the magnificent southern night sky. Our guide will point out the visible constellations and share Aboriginal stories connected to the stars, providing a fitting finale to your Uluru experience before returning to your accommodation.
