Day 1 – Thursday, 09 September 2027
Arrive Copenhagen, Denmark

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Today those passengers who are travelling on the same flights as the tour host from Brisbane will arrive in Copenhagen. All other passengers are to meet at Copenhagen International airport.

On arrival we will be welcomed by a representative who will assist us to the coach as we begin a sightseeing tour prior to a light lunch.

We check into the hotel late this afternoon and have the evening at leisure to relax and get a good night's sleep.

Day 2 – Friday, 10 September 2027
Copenhagen, Denmark

After breakfast, we join a local guide for a comprehensive tour of **Copenhagen**, discovering the many highlights of Denmark's elegant capital.

Travelling by coach, we'll explore the city's grand boulevards, historic landmarks and royal precincts while learning about Copenhagen's fascinating history and modern Scandinavian lifestyle.

Our sightseeing brings us to the colourful waterfront district of **Nyhavn**, where we enjoy lunch overlooking the harbour. Afterwards, there is time to explore this iconic area at our own pace, perhaps browsing the boutique shops, enjoying the lively atmosphere, or simply soaking up the charm of the beautifully preserved 17th-century buildings.

This afternoon, we see Copenhagen from a different perspective as we board a classic **one-hour canal cruise**. Gliding through the city's picturesque waterways, we'll pass many of its famous attractions, including elegant palaces, historic churches and striking contemporary architecture.

Following the cruise, there is further free time to explore before returning to our hotel to freshen up.

This evening, we gather for a wonderful **Welcome Dinner** at the acclaimed Aye Aye Restaurant within the historic hotel.

Day 3 – Saturday, 11 September 2027
Copenhagen, Denmark

After breakfast, we farewell our hotel and travel with our local guide through the picturesque Danish countryside to magnificent **Frederiksborg Castle**. Set on three small islands and surrounded by a beautiful lake and formal gardens, this spectacular Renaissance castle is one of Denmark's most treasured landmarks. Enjoy time to explore the lavishly decorated interiors, fascinating museum collections and stunning grounds while discovering the rich history of the Danish monarchy.

Returning to Copenhagen, we visit the famous **Tivoli Gardens**, one of the world's oldest and most enchanting amusement parks. With its beautiful gardens, charming architecture, boutique shops and inviting cafés, there is plenty of time to wander at your own pace.

Please note This tour by coach includes moderate walking. You may need to climb some stairs. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions.

Lunch today is at your leisure (& own expense), allowing you to choose from the many restaurants and eateries within Tivoli Gardens.

In the mid-afternoon, we transfer to the Copenhagen cruise terminal where we board our cruise ship. After time to settle into our cabins, we will meet for the cruise safety briefing. Then it will be time for dinner, and we begin the next exciting chapter of our Scandinavian adventure.

Day 4 – Sunday, 12 September 2027
Warnemünde (Berlin), Germany

After enjoying breakfast on board, we disembark in **Warnemünde** for a full-day excursion through the beautiful Mecklenburg region.

Travelling through picturesque countryside, we first visit the UNESCO World Heritage city of **Wismar**, where a guided walking tour showcases its magnificent Market Square, striking Brick Gothic architecture and rich Hanseatic trading history. There will also be time to soak up the atmosphere of the historic harbour before continuing to the elegant lakeside city of **Schwerin**.

Famed for its enchanting fairytale castle set on an island in **Lake Schwerin**, the city offers charming streets, picturesque squares and beautiful waterfront promenades. While entry to the castle is *not included*, we'll enjoy a guided tour of the historic centre followed by free time to wander, browse the local shops or capture photographs of the spectacular castle from the surrounding gardens and lakeside. Lunch today is at your *own expense* before we return to the ship later this afternoon.

Please note: This tour by coach is approx. 6 hours, includes considerable walking with longer distances, may include uneven surfaces, some stairs and is unsuitable for guests of limited mobility. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions.

Day 6 – Tuesday, 14 September 2027
Vik I Sogn, Norway

After breakfast on board, we set off from **Vik** to discover some of Norway's most spectacular mountain scenery.

Travelling through breathtaking landscapes of towering peaks, tranquil valleys and dramatic fjords, we pause at the magnificent **Storesvingen and Hólesvingane** viewpoints, where there is time to admire the sweeping panoramas and capture unforgettable photographs.

Our journey continues to the charming town of Voss, where we ride the Voss Gondola to the summit of **Hangurstoppen**. From this spectacular mountain viewpoint, we take in breathtaking alpine scenery while enjoying time to wander and soak up the crisp mountain air.

Later, we visit the impressive **Tvindefossen Waterfall**, where cascading waters tumble through lush green surrounds, creating one of Norway's most picturesque natural attractions.

Returning to the ship later this afternoon, we enjoy lunch and dinner on board as we continue our unforgettable cruise through the spectacular Norwegian fjords.

Please note: This tour by coach includes moderate walking. You may need to climb some stairs and it is unsuitable for guests of limited mobility and those that suffer vertigo. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions. Views are subject to favourable weather conditions.

Day 7 – Wednesday, 15 September 2027
Eidfjord, Norway

After breakfast on board, we disembark in **Eidfjord** for an unforgettable journey through some of Norway's most spectacular landscapes. Travelling by coach, we cross the impressive **Hardanger Bridge** and pass shimmering lakes, cascading waterfalls and dramatic mountain scenery en route to the popular alpine town of **Voss**, where we enjoy lunch.



Continuing through breathtaking countryside, we pause at the beautiful **Tvindefossen Waterfall** before descending the famous **Stalheimskleiva**, one of Norway's steepest and most scenic mountain roads.

In the picturesque village of **Flåm**, we board the world-renowned **Flåm Railway** for one of the most spectacular rail journeys on earth. Climbing from the fjord to the mountain station of Myrdal, the train winds through towering peaks, deep valleys, waterfalls and tunnels, with incredible views at every turn.

We then continue aboard the historic **Bergen Railway** back towards Voss before rejoining our coach for the scenic return journey to Eidfjord. During the drive back we may have a photo stop to admire the Skjervet waterfall *if the train schedule allows*.

This evening, we return to the ship and enjoy dinner on board as we continue cruising through Norway's magnificent fjord country.

Please note: This tour by coach includes moderate walking. You may need to climb some stairs. This tour includes passing through many tunnels and is unsuitable for guests suffering from claustrophobia. It is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties; there are steps to get on/off the train. The order of the visits may change.

Day 8 – Thursday, 16 September 2027
Sandnes, Norway

Following breakfast this morning we set off to explore the beautiful countryside surrounding **Sandnes**.

Travelling alongside the picturesque Dirdal River, we journey through peaceful valleys to the charming **Byrkjedalstunet**, a beautifully restored former cheese factory that celebrates Norway's rural heritage. Here, we enjoy a traditional Norwegian morning tea featuring delicious *lapper* (thick pancakes) served with jam and sour cream, accompanied by tea or coffee. There is also time to browse the delightful gift shop, showcasing locally made handicrafts, woollens and candles.

Back on the coach we then continue to **Gloppedalsura**, Norway's largest boulder field, where enormous glacial rocks create a truly remarkable natural landscape and provide a wonderful photo opportunity.

Our scenic drive back to the port takes us through the fertile farming plains of Jæren and past the beautiful beaches of Sola, with sweeping views across the North Sea, before returning to the ship.

This evening, enjoy dinner on board as our Norwegian coastal adventure continues.

Please note: This tour by coach includes moderate walking. You may need to climb some stairs. This tour is unsuitable for guests with limited mobility. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions. Views are subject to favourable weather conditions.



Day 9 – Friday, 17 September 2027
Oslo, Norway

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we set out to explore the vibrant Norwegian capital of **Oslo** on a guided sightseeing tour.

Travelling through the city's elegant streets and squares, we pass many of its most iconic landmarks, including the striking Opera House, the modern Munch Museum and the Royal Palace, while learning about Oslo's rich history and contemporary culture.

We visit the renowned **Vigeland Sculpture Park**, home to more than 150 remarkable sculptures by Gustav Vigeland depicting the human journey from birth to old age.

We then continue to **Holmenkollen**, where spectacular panoramic views across Oslo provide the perfect photo opportunity.

Our tour concludes in the stylish waterfront district of **Tjuvholmen**, known for its striking modern architecture, vibrant atmosphere and impressive contemporary art. Here, you may choose to enjoy a guided stroll along the harbour before returning to the ship.

This evening, we gather for dinner as we farewell Norway and continue our Scandinavian voyage.

Please note: This tour by coach includes moderate walking. You will need to climb some stairs to reach the monolith inside Vigeland Park which is unsuitable for guests of limited mobility. Day 10 – Saturday, 18 September 2027

Strolling along the picturesque **Alter Strom** harbour, we'll admire colourful fishing boats, elegant yachts, traditional fishermen's cottages and the town's iconic lighthouse while learning about Warnemünde's fascinating history.

Our walk also takes us to the impressive **Kurhaus**, a striking Art Deco building that has been welcoming visitors since the early 20th century. Following the guided tour, there is free time to browse the local shops, relax at one of the waterfront cafés or simply soak up the coastal atmosphere before returning to the ship at your leisure.

This evening, enjoy a dinner on board as we reflect on the wonderful experiences and unforgettable scenery of our Scandinavian voyage so far.

Please note: This tour includes 2 hours of moderate walking, at times over uneven surfaces. You may need to climb some stairs. This tour is unsuitable for guests with limited mobility.

Day 12 – Monday, 20 September 2027
Gdynia (Gdansk-Danzig), Poland

Today after breakfast we travel to the historic city of **Gdańsk**, where we begin our exploration at the **European Solidarity Centre**.

This fascinating museum tells the story of Poland's struggle for freedom and the rise of the Solidarity movement, which played a pivotal role in ending Communist rule. We also view the moving **Solidarity Monument**, commemorating those who lost their lives during the workers' protests of 1970.

We then continue into Gdańsk's beautifully restored **Old Town**, where a **guided walking tour** reveals its rich maritime heritage and stunning architecture. Strolling along the picturesque **Motława River**, we discover landmarks including **Long Market**, the **Main Town Hall**, **Arthur's Court**, the famous **Neptune Fountain**, and the magnificent **St. Mary's Church**, the largest brick church in the world.

Following our guided tour, there is free time to get lunch (*own expense*) browse the charming shops, enjoy the lively atmosphere or simply soak up the beauty of this remarkable city before returning to the ship.

This evening, we meet for dinner on board as our adventure continues.

Please note: This tour by coach is approx. 7 hours, including considerable walking with longer distances, may include uneven surfaces, and some stairs and is unsuitable for guests of limited mobility. **Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits.** Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions.



Day 13 – Tuesday, 21 September 2027
Klaipėda, Lithuania

Following breakfast today we discover the maritime charm of **Klaipėda**, Lithuania's oldest city.

Our guided walking tour begins in the picturesque Theatre Square, home to the famous **Ännchen von Tharau** statue, before wandering through the historic Old Town with its distinctive timber-framed buildings, cobbled streets and market stalls offering local handicrafts and beautiful amber jewellery.

We then travel to the seaside resort of **Palanga**, where we stroll through the magnificent **Botanical Gardens** surrounding the elegant **Tiškevičiai Palace**. Here, we visit the renowned **Palanga Amber Museum**, learning about the history, formation and significance of the Baltic's famous "gold".

Afterwards, there is free time to explore Palanga's lively promenade, browse the shops, relax at a café or take a walk to the shores of the Baltic Sea before returning to the ship and coming together for dinner.

Please note: This tour includes moderate walking on cobblestone streets in Klaipėda old town and you will need to climb some stairs which may not be suitable for guests with limited mobility. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions. Guests can choose to remain in Klaipėda's old town, about 800 m from the ship, after the end of the tour; maps can be provided.

Day 14 – Wednesday, 22 September 2027
Riga, Latvia

After breakfast on board, we explore the elegant Latvian capital of **Riga**.

This enjoyable sightseeing tour will introduce you to the lovely city of Riga, the capital of Latvia. The tour includes visits at the **Orthodox Cathedral**, the **Freedom Monument**, and the building of the **Fine Art Museum**.

After reaching the old part of the town, we will continue on foot to **Theatre Square** and on the town hall square, past **St. Peter's Church**, **St. George's Church** and **St. John's Church**. A certain highlight of the tour is the **brief recital** of organ music at **Riga's Dome Cathedral**.

We will also have a chance to see the outside of the **Swedish Gates** and **Riga Castle**. Be sure to take your camera so as to capture the undeniable beauty of the city's historical centre, which was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site particularly because of its unparalleled Art Nouveau architecture.

We return to the ship and enjoy dinner on board as we sail towards our next destination.

Please note: This tour by coach includes considerable walking and you will need to climb some stairs. This tour is unsuitable for guests with limited mobility. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions. Guests are also requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. There might be a fee to use restrooms at any site visited; local currency and credit cards are accepted.



Day 15 – Thursday, 23 September 2027
Tallin, Estonia

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we set out to discover the highlights of **Tallinn**, one of Europe's best-preserved medieval capitals.

Our short, but photo-rich, panoramic coach tour takes us to **Toompea Hill**, where we admire the historic Hermann Tower and enjoy wonderful views across the city's fairytale skyline of church spires and red-tiled rooftops.

Continuing through the city, we visit the elegant **Kadriorg Park**, created by Peter the Great as a summer residence, before stopping at the renowned **Song Festival Grounds**, a powerful symbol of Estonia's national identity and independence.

We also visit the moving **Memorial to the Victims of Communism**, the atmospheric ruins of **St Birgit's Convent**, and the picturesque **Pirita Marina**, famous for its sandy beaches and Olympic sailing history.

Returning to the ship, we pass several notable landmarks, including the **Russalka Memorial**, completing a memorable introduction to Estonia's charming capital.

Please note: This tour by coach may include some walking. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions.

Day 16 – Friday, 24 September 2027
Helsinki, Finland

After breakfast this morning's breakfast, we journey through the Finnish countryside to the charming medieval town of **Porvoo**, one of Finland's oldest and most picturesque settlements.

Set along the banks of the **Porvoo River**, the town is renowned for its colourful red riverside storehouses, cobbled streets and beautifully preserved wooden houses. During our guided walk, we explore the enchanting **Old Town**, browse its delightful handicraft shops and enjoy time at leisure to soak up the atmosphere or relax in one of the quaint cafés.

Returning to **Helsinki**, we enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of Finland's elegant capital. Highlights include the bustling Market Square, the impressive **Uspenski Cathedral**, the **Presidential Palace**, and a photo stop at the beautiful **Senate Square**, the historic heart of the city.

After our tour, we return to the ship to continue our Scandinavian adventure with dinner on board as we cruise towards our next destination.

Please note: This tour by coach includes moderate walking on cobblestone streets in Porvoo. You may need to climb some stairs. This tour is unsuitable for guests with limited mobility. Please wear comfortable shoes and dress according to the weather conditions.

Stockholm, Sweden
