Day 1: Saturday, 04 September 2027
Arrive Vancouver, Canada

We will have a Welcome Lunch together and then make our way to the hotel where the remainder of the afternoon and evening is at leisure.

Day 2: Sunday, 05 September 2027
Vancouver

Begin your day with **breakfast at the hotel** before setting out to discover the spectacular scenery of Vancouver's beautiful North Shore.

Your sightseeing begins with a visit to **Grouse Mountain**, one of Vancouver's most iconic natural attractions. Journey up the mountain and enjoy access to the mountaintop, where spectacular panoramic views stretch across the city skyline, Pacific Ocean, and surrounding coastal mountains. Take time to explore the mountaintop surroundings, breathe in the fresh mountain air, and appreciate the impressive alpine scenery that makes Grouse Mountain a favourite year-round destination.

Later, continue to the renowned **Capilano Suspension Bridge Park**, where you can experience the beauty of the West Coast rainforest from three breathtaking perspectives. A highlight is crossing the world-famous **Capilano Suspension Bridge**, stretching 137 metres (450 ft) across and suspended 70 metres (230 ft) above the Capilano River.

We return to the hotel and have time to freshen up before we come together and enjoy **dinner**, bringing a memorable day of sightseeing amid Vancouver's spectacular natural surroundings to a relaxing close.



Day 3: Monday, 06 September 2027
Whistler

Following an early breakfast at the hotel, we depart Vancouver for a full-day excursion to **Whistler**, travelling along the spectacular **Sea to Sky Highway**, renowned for its dramatic coastal and mountain scenery. En route, we pass through the historic lumber town of **Squamish** and stop to admire **Shannon Falls**, one of British Columbia's highest waterfalls, where cascading waters tumble dramatically through a beautiful, forested setting.

We then continue to the world-famous **Whistler Village**, nestled at the base of **Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains**. Internationally acclaimed as a premier ski destination, Whistler is equally as captivating during the summer months, when its alpine landscapes provide a magnificent backdrop for outdoor activities and sightseeing. Enjoy time to explore the lively pedestrian village, with its charming shops, cafés and restaurants. The surrounding mountains offer an abundance of natural beauty, while nearby **Garibaldi Provincial Park** is renowned for its rugged peaks, deep ravines, pristine lakes and spectacular wilderness scenery.

In the late afternoon, we depart Whistler and journey back along the scenic Sea to Sky Highway, arriving in **Vancouver** in the early evening. Tonight, enjoy dinner and a relaxing evening after exploring the magnificent landscapes of British Columbia.

Day 4: Tuesday, 07 September 2027
Vancouver – Kamloops via ROCKY MOUNTAINEER

This morning after breakfast, we check out and transfer from the hotel to the Rocky Mountaineer station, where we will board the legendary **Rocky Mountaineer** and begin our spectacular rail journey through the Canadian Rockies.

Since 1990, Rocky Mountaineer has been showcasing some of Western Canada's most magnificent landscapes from the comfort of its luxury trains. Settle into the expansive glass-dome coach and watch the scenery unfold, accompanied by engaging onboard storytelling, exceptional service and delicious regionally inspired cuisine.

Today's journey takes us from the coastal city of **Vancouver to Kamloops**, in the heart of British Columbia's interior. As the train leaves Vancouver behind, it travels through the fertile farmlands of the **Fraser Valley** before the landscape gradually transforms into dramatic canyons, rugged mountains and the drier terrain of the province's interior.

Along the way, we can enjoy views of memorable landmarks including **Hell's Gate**, where the Fraser River surges through a narrow canyon, the historic railway bridges at **Cisco Crossing**, and the expansive waters and striking scenery of **Kamloops Lake**. With ever-changing landscapes visible through the panoramic windows, the journey itself is very much part of the experience.

Lunch is served onboard, with beverages and snacks also included throughout our journey.

Upon arrival in **Kamloops**, we will be transferred by coach our overnight, 3 Star, accommodation, which is arranged by the Rocky Mountaineer. The remainder of the evening is at leisure, providing an opportunity to relax at the hotel or explore the local surroundings at our own pace.

Kamloops - Jasper via ROCKY MOUNTAINEER

Early this morning, we transfer by coach back to the **Rocky Mountaineer** station, where we will board the train and continue our unforgettable rail journey east towards **Jasper** and the magnificent **Canadian Rockies**. Settle back into the comfort of the Rocky Mountaineer and enjoy another day of spectacular scenery as the train travels alongside the **North Thompson River**, winding through the impressive **Monashee and Cariboo Mountains** and deeper into the dramatic landscapes of the Canadian Rockies.

Throughout the journey, admire an ever-changing panorama of forested valleys, rushing rivers, pristine lakes and soaring mountain peaks. Highlights include magnificent **Mount Robson**, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, the cascading waters of **Pyramid Falls**, and the beautiful **Moose Lake**, renowned for its crystal-clear waters and picturesque mountain setting.

Breakfast and lunch are served onboard, with beverages and snacks also included throughout the journey, allowing everyone to relax and enjoy the passing scenery from the comfort of the train.

Upon arrival in Jasper, our Tour Director & driver will be waiting to meet and assist us from the railway station to our hotel. We have time to settle in and before we come together for dinner.

Day 6: Thursday, 09 September 2027
Jasper

We begin the day with breakfast at the hotel before departing on a full-day sightseeing tour through the magnificent landscapes of **Jasper National Park**. The largest national park in the Canadian Rockies, Jasper is a vast wilderness of soaring mountain peaks, ancient glaciers, alpine meadows, rushing rivers and tranquil, mirror-like lakes. Today's journey showcases some of the park's most picturesque scenery and celebrated natural attractions.

Visit beautiful **Patricia Lake and Pyramid Lake**, both set against a spectacular backdrop of forested slopes and rugged mountain peaks. Continue to **Maligne Canyon**, an impressive natural gorge carved over thousands of years by the rushing waters of the Maligne River. Enjoy the dramatic scenery of the canyon before travelling deeper into the park towards magnificent **Maligne Lake**.

Surrounded by towering peaks and pristine wilderness, Maligne Lake is the **largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies** and one of Canada's most photographed destinations. Here, we will embark on a **narrated scenic cruise**, offering a wonderful opportunity to admire the lake's brilliant waters, dramatic mountain scenery and unspoilt surroundings from a unique perspective.

Following a memorable day exploring the natural wonders of Jasper National Park, we return to the hotel and enjoy dinner together.

Please note: Access to Maligne Canyon remains subject to reopening following the Jasper wildfires. Its inclusion in the itinerary is dependent upon confirmed public access at the time of travel.



Day 7: Friday, 10 September 2027
Jasper - Banff

Following breakfast, we check out, board the coach and travel along the spectacular **Icefields Parkway**, one of Canada's most celebrated scenic routes, connecting Jasper with the magnificent landscapes of **Banff National Park**. Throughout the drive, it is an ever-changing panorama of turquoise glacial lakes, rushing mountain streams, dense forests, sweeping valleys and majestic snow-capped peaks.

A highlight of the day is a visit to the remarkable **Columbia Icefield**, one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle. Here, we will board a specially designed **Ice Explorer** for an unforgettable journey onto the **Athabasca Glacier**, one of six principal glaciers flowing from the Columbia Icefield. Travel across the ancient ice to a designated area where we can step out onto the glacier, take photographs and experience this extraordinary frozen landscape surrounded by the towering peaks of the Canadian Rockies.

After this incredible glacier experience, we continue south through the breathtaking mountain scenery of the Icefields Parkway towards **Banff**, located in the heart of Banff National Park.

Upon arrival, we have time to settle into our rooms before this evenings dinner this evening, bringing an unforgettable day in the Canadian Rockies to a relaxing close.

Day 8: Saturday, 11 September 2027
Banff

After breakfast we set out to explore the spectacular scenery and attractions surrounding **Banff**.

Established in 1885 to protect the area's natural hot springs, **Banff National Park** was Canada's first national park and today forms part of the magnificent Canadian Rocky Mountain Parks UNESCO World Heritage Site. Surrounded by soaring peaks, pristine forests and turquoise waterways, the region offers some of the most iconic scenery in the Canadian Rockies.

This morning's sightseeing includes some of Banff's best-known landmarks. See the historic **Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel**, dramatically situated against its mountain backdrop, before continuing to **Tunnel Mountain** and picturesque **Bow Falls**.

A highlight of the morning is a ride aboard the **Banff Gondola**, ascending to the summit of Sulphur Mountain. From the top, enjoy sweeping panoramic views across the Bow Valley, the town of Banff and the surrounding peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Following sightseeing, we enjoy **lunch** before continuing to magnificent **Lake Louise**, one of Canada's most photographed natural landmarks.

We return to Banff, where the afternoon and evening is at leisure. Your Tour Host will be available should you require any assistance or recommendations. Dinner this evening is at your own arrangement and expense, providing the opportunity to discover one of Banff's many restaurants and enjoy the mountain town at your own pace.



Day 9: Sunday, 12 September 2027
Banff – Calgary – Seattle (USA)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before bidding farewell to the magnificent Canadian Rockies and as we Banff for **Calgary**. Travelling east along the **Trans-Canada Highway**, watch as the dramatic mountain landscapes gradually give way to the rolling foothills and open plains of Alberta.

Upon arrival in Calgary, we have a **sightseeing tour of the city**, discovering some of the landmarks and attractions of this vibrant western Canadian destination. Highlights include views of the iconic **Calgary Tower**, the famous **Calgary Stampede Grounds**, lively **Stephen Avenue**, the downtown financial district and sites associated with the **1988 Winter Olympic Games**, which helped establish Calgary on the international stage.

Following **lunch**, we transfer to **Calgary International Airport** for our flight to Seattle.

Please note: All passengers must have obtained, prior to departing Australia, a United States of America ESTA.

Welcome to Seattle! Upon arrival at **Seattle-Tacoma International Airport**, we will be met by a local guide and driver who will welcome us and transfer us to our hotel to check in.

The remainder of the evening is at leisure, with dinner at own arrangement and expense, providing an opportunity to relax or begin discovering Seattle.

Day 12: Wednesday, 15 September 2027
Ketchikan

We arrive in **Ketchikan** early this morning, surrounded by the spectacular forested landscapes of Alaska's Inside Passage.

Following breakfast onboard, disembark for today's shore excursion to **Saxman Native Village**, offering a fascinating introduction to the culture, traditions and heritage of Alaska's Indigenous peoples.

Step into living history at Saxman Native Village, where you'll explore the rich culture of Southeast Alaska's Indigenous people. Begin your experience at the thrilling Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show, an action-packed competition that brings logging history to life with impressive feats of strength and skill. At Saxman, you'll be welcomed into the Beaver Clan House to witness a captivating performance of traditional Tlingit songs and dances. Feel the rhythm of drums and watch dancers in authentic regalia bring ancient stories of fierce warriors to life. After the performance, your guide will lead you through the canoe canopy, sharing insights into traditional canoe making and fishing techniques. Then, visit the Carving Centre to see master artisans at work creating and painting totem poles. Finally, explore the totem pole park, where detailed descriptions reveal the cultural significance behind each intricately carved figure.

Please note: It is recommended that guests wear proper weather gear, and footwear, for this tour. There will be walking and standing involved in this tour, which may include slippery, uneven terrain. Passengers with mobility issues will not be able to partake in this tour. Tour order may vary.

Following the excursion, we return to Ketchikan, with a little time to enjoy the colourful waterfront town and its unique Alaskan atmosphere before returning to the ship.

Come together for dinner this evening as the ship sets sails for our next destination.



Day 13: Thursday, 16 September 2027
Icy Strait Hoonah

Enjoy breakfast before mid-morning our ship arrives at **Icy Strait Hoonah**. Once docked we set out on an exciting excursion in search of **Whales, Wildlife and Bears**

*On this excursion of around five hours, we explore the wildlife-rich waters of Icy Strait and attempt to catch a glimpse of the area's coastal brown bears further inland. To begin, there's around 15 minutes to assemble at the dock before departing on a **whale-watching cruise**, lasting around two hours.*

The nutrient-rich waters here are known to attract humpback whales, who travel here to feed. This means that whale viewings are common, although please note that wildlife sightings can't be guaranteed. The whale-watching vessel offers indoor seating if you want to stay warm, while those who want to view as much scenery as possible can head to outdoor viewing decks.

*After returning to shore, disembarkation takes about 15 minutes, followed by a short transfer to our waiting vehicle, although transfer times can vary and may take up to 30 minutes. We will have a narrated drive of 45 minutes or so through the **Tlingit** community of Hoonah and into the **Spasski River Valley**, a remote interior area recognised for its high concentration of coastal brown bears.*

*A guide will then escort us on a walk of around 730 metres, following forest trails and passing wetland terrain to reach viewing platforms above the Spasski River. Here, we will learn about **coastal brown bear** behaviour and habitat and the reasons that this area provides ideal feeding conditions. This means we have a good chance of spotting a bear, but again, please note that sightings can't be guaranteed. The guided walk and time on the viewing platforms will last about 50 minutes in total.*

The excursion concludes with a roughly 45-minute return drive to Icy Strait Point, followed by a short time to disembark the vehicle before rejoining the ship.

Please note: *It is recommended that guests wear layered clothing, comfortable non-slip walking shoes, and bring a rain jacket. Weather conditions can change rapidly in Southeast Alaska. The spotting of wildlife is not guaranteed. Food is not permitted on this tour. Passengers who suffer motion/sea sickness are required to ensure they have appropriate medications or treatments with them. There will be standing involved in this tour passengers must be capable of walking approximately 1km on uneven terrain, boardwalks, and gravel, during the bear search portion of this tour. Passengers with mobility issues will not be able to partake in this tour.*

Following the excursion, we board the ship and freshen up before coming together for dinner.



Day 14: Friday, 17 September 2027
Juneau

During breakfast time we sail into Juneau. Once we are able to disembark, we will enjoy an excursion to **Mendenhall Glacier, The Macaulay Salmon Hatchery and the Gold Creek Salmon Bake!**

Discover Alaska's capital city with a perfect blend of sights and flavours, featuring Mendenhall Glacier, the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery, and an Alaska-style meal at Gold Creek Salmon Bake.

We start our adventure at the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area, home to Alaska's only "drive-up" glacier. We can take our time exploring the Visitor Centre, enjoying various viewpoints, and wandering the trails as our schedule allows.

Next, we head to the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery, where we gain insight into how Alaska's fisheries thrive and the hatchery's vital role in sustaining these rich resources.

Our tour concludes with a short ride to Gold Creek Salmon Bake, where we'll savour grilled wild Alaskan salmon and a selection of tasty side dishes, all served under a cozy canopy. After our meal, we take a brief transfer back to the ship.

Please note: *the order of sights visited on the day may vary. It is recommended that guests dress in layers and wear comfortable walking shoes. There will be walking and standing involved in this tour, which may include slippery, uneven terrain. Passengers with mobility issues will not be able to partake in this tour.*

Before re-joining the ship you may like to visit some of the local shops and spend a little time in the town.

Back on board, we meet in the evening for dinner.

Day 15: Saturday, 18 September 2027
At Sea

Soft lighting enhances the shapes of the plants and flowers, creating a tranquil experience. The **Ross Fountain**, already a highlight during the day, becomes a spectacle with dynamic light shows. The arranged illumination along the paths adds to the ambiance, making an evening stroll through the gardens feel like stepping into a fairytale.*

*After taking in this attraction, we continue to Victoria's **Inner Harbour** to view the iconic **Empress Hotel** and **BC Legislative Buildings**, passing through the "**Gates of Harmonious Interest**" to see **Chinatown**, the second oldest in North America. We then travel past Old Town making our way back to the cruise ship.*

Please note: *It is recommended that guests wear layered clothing and comfortable non-slip walking shoes. There will be walking and standing involved in this tour, which may include slippery, uneven terrain. Passengers with mobility issues will not be able to partake in this tour.*

Day 17: Sunday, 20 September 2027
Depart Seattle

Seattle is a thriving port city known for its striking skyline, lively waterfront and fascinating blend of historic architecture and contemporary skyscrapers. Today's sightseeing will introduce us to some of the city's best-known landmarks and neighbourhoods.

Highlights include **Pike Place Market**, one of Seattle's most famous attractions, historic **Pioneer Square**, the bustling **Waterfront**, the **Financial District** and **Capitol Hill**. We will also enjoy an exterior view of the iconic **Space Needle**, the instantly recognisable landmark that has become a symbol of the city.

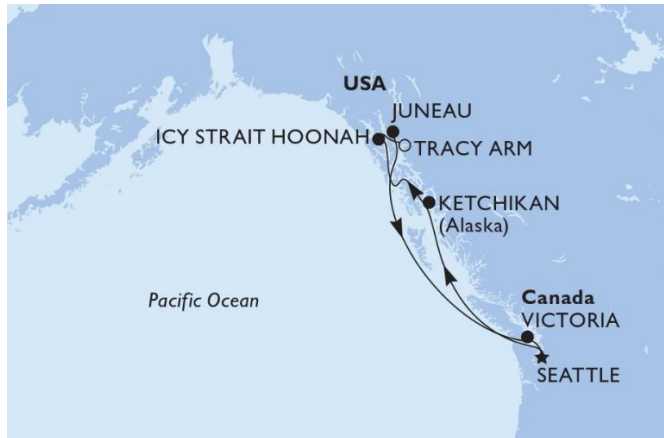
