Woodlands Homestead is a unique and treasured heritage building that now houses an extensive art collection, historic artefacts and horse racing memorabilia.

Living Legends is home to some of Australia's finest retired champion racehorses including Melbourne Cup winners, Might & Power (1997), Rogan Josh (1999) and Efficient (2007). Here we enjoy a **self-guided tour** followed by **morning tea**.

We return to the Parkroyal Melbourne Airport to collect our luggage before making our way to the terminal to board our lunchtime flight (**not included in tour cost**) to King Island, where the next chapter of your adventure begins.

This afternoon, we arrive on beautiful **King Island** where we are welcomed and transferred to **Currie**, the island's picturesque main township. En route, enjoy an introductory tour showcasing the island's fascinating history, dramatic coastal scenery, and local landmarks, offering a wonderful insight into this unique and unspoilt destination.

Following our tour, we check in to our accommodation, and you will have time to settle in and relax before coming together for dinner at the acclaimed **Wild Harvest Restaurant**. This evening we get to know our fellow travellers while enjoying the fresh local flavours for which King Island is renowned.

This evening, enjoy a special wildlife experience at **Grassy Harbour**, where we watch Little **Penguins** return ashore after dark a memorable end to a wonderful day on King Island.
